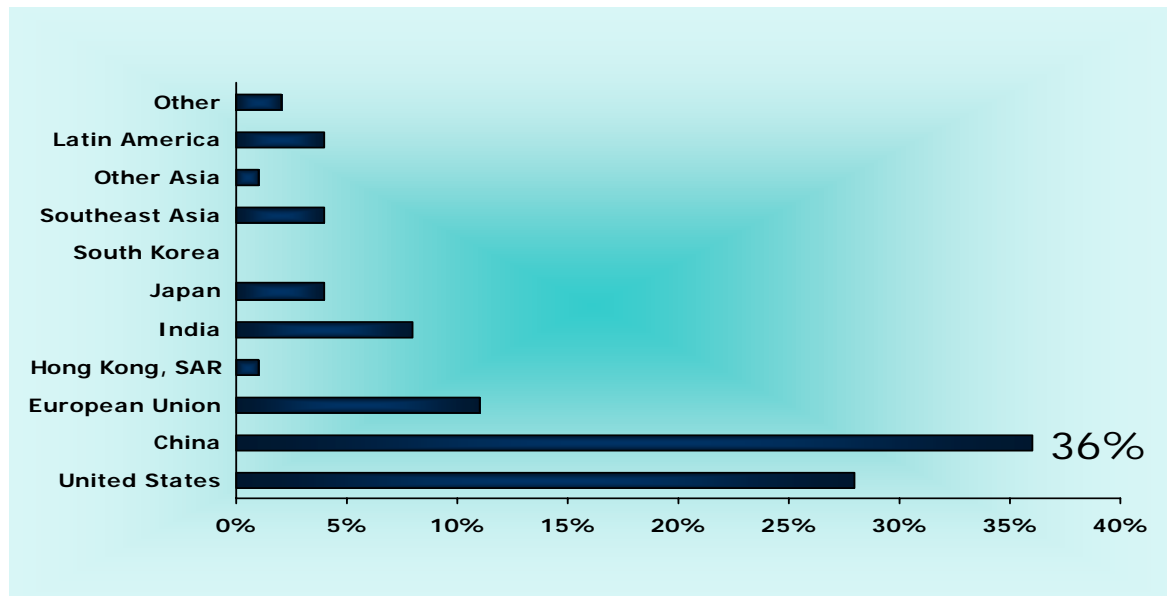

“In your view, which one of the following markets holds the most potential for Canadian exports and investment?”



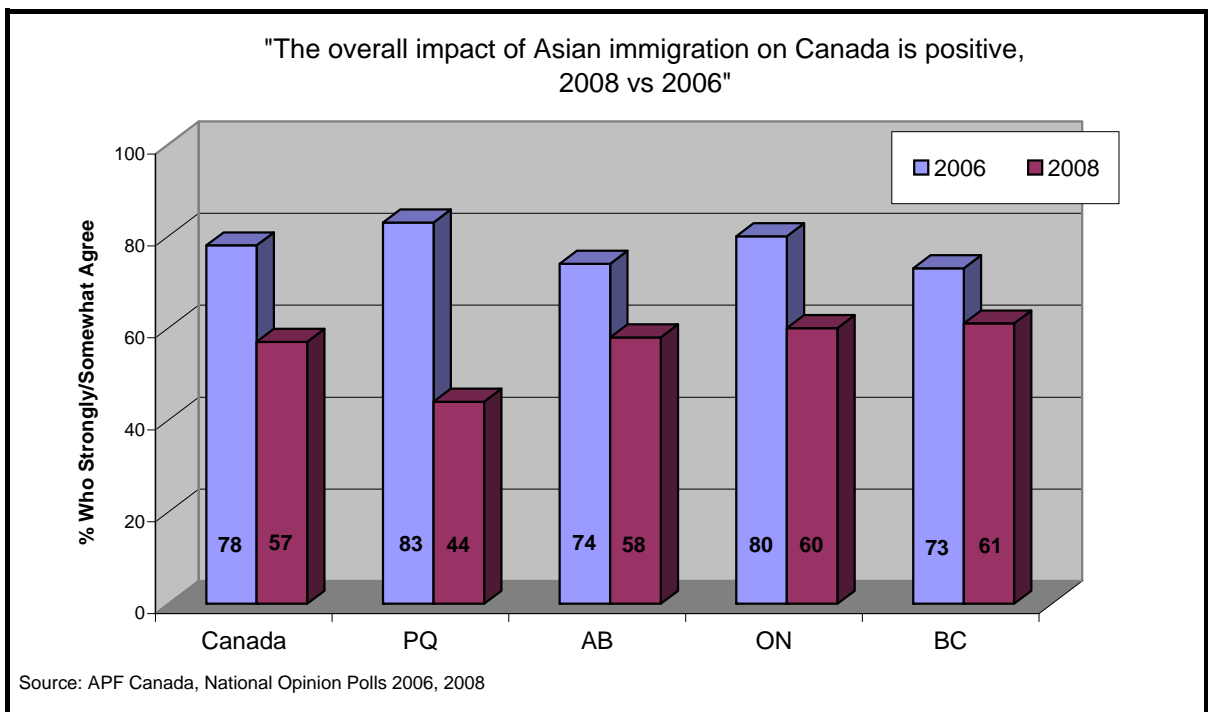

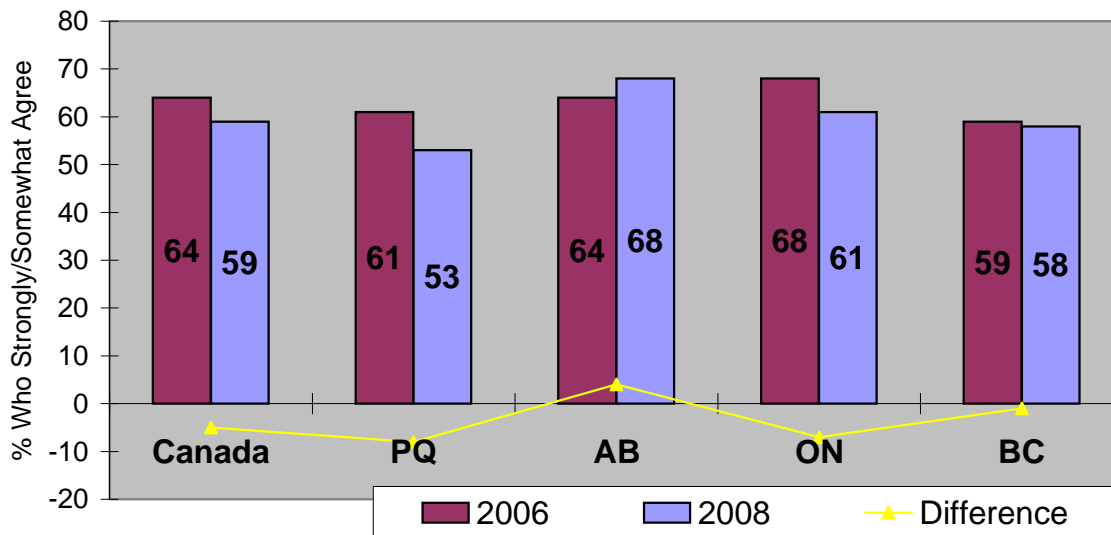

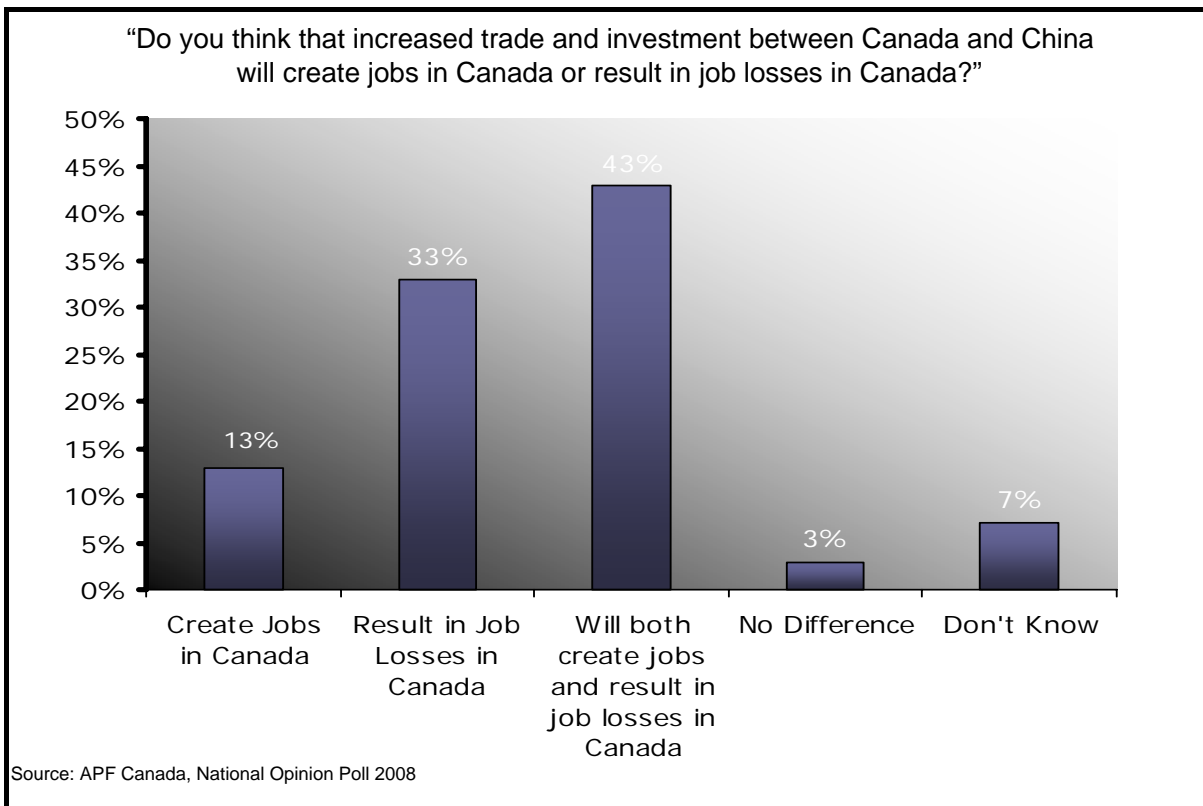

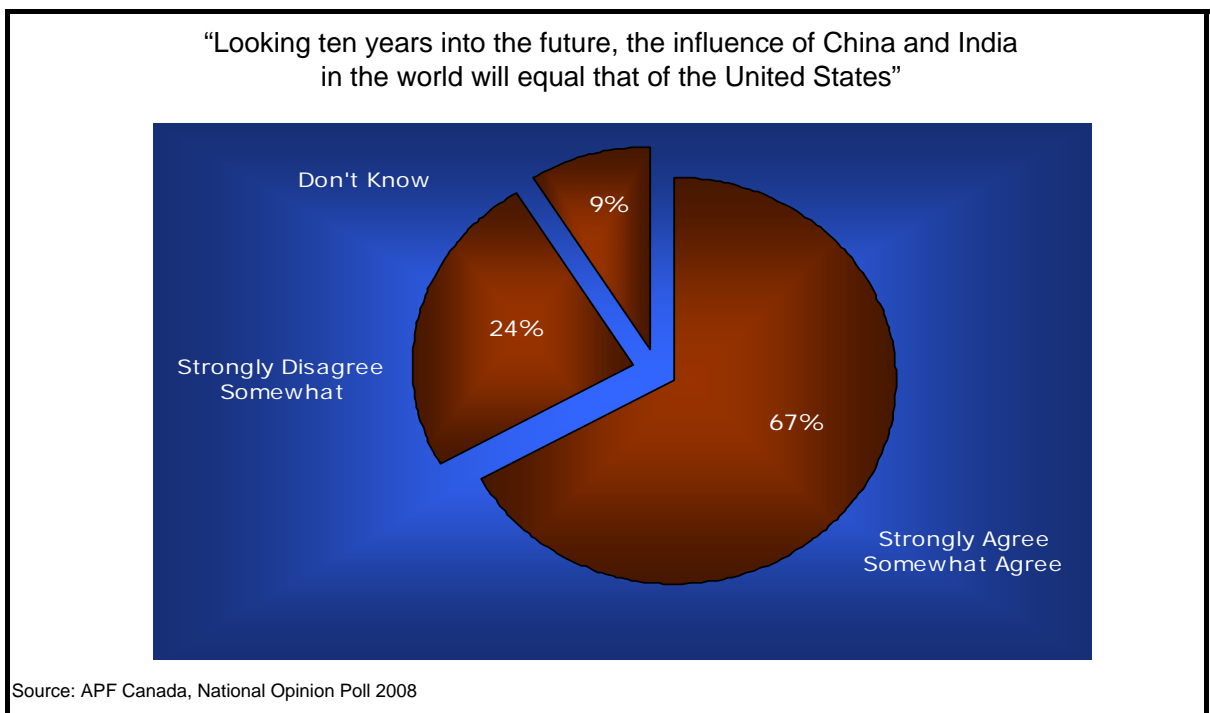
